Courses

Reading Intensive

This course is offered to students who are reading significantly below grade level. It focuses on phonics and fluency to build students' foundational reading skills.

Reading Support

This is a required course for graduation. All students enrolled in a reading intervention course will be concurrently enrolled in this class in order to remain on track for graduation.
