
TUHSD Tech Quick Guide: Saving Online Videos for Educational Use


Why should I save an online video for future educational use?

It has become easier to stream videos and show them in our classes for educational purposes. However, doing so puts a large strain on our internet servers when multiple teachers are using this function simultaneously. Saving videos also addresses the concerns about broken, unavailable, or lost video web links (URLs) in the future. By using a third-party conversion site—*and being mindful of copyright and fair use laws*-- videos can be converted and saved locally so that they can be used **appropriately** in your classes.

1. Locate and copy the video link you wish to use.



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5. Enter your email address and then click on "Convert."



6. Once the conversion is complete, you will receive an email notification with a download link.
