GOVERNING BOARD MINUTES REGULAR MEETING and WORK STUDY SESSION TUESDAY, AUGUST 9, 2022

REGULAR MEETING

1. Call to Order of Regular Meeting and Roll Call

The Tolleson Union High School District No. 214 Governing Board regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Governing Board President, Mr. Freddie Villalon, with the following members in attendance: Dr. Elda Luna-Najera, Vice President, Mr. Steven Chapman, Mr. Devin Del Palacio, and Dr. Kino Flores, Members.

2. Pledge of Allegiance and National Anthem

President Villalon asked Dr. Flores to lead the pledge of allegiance.

3. Approval of the Regular Agenda

Mr. Chapman moved to approve the Regular Agenda; seconded by Mr. Del Palacio. In a roll call vote, the motion carried 5-0.

4. Celebration/Recognition

A. Civics Matters Update

Mrs. Mindy Westover, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction, introduced Mr. John Brown, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, who shared information and introduced participants that attended the CLOSE UP – Civics Matters program in Washington, D.C. The Civics Matters program prioritizes teaching American Civics in schools.

Nearly 300 Arizona high school students and teachers visited Washington, D.C. in June. Nineteen TUHSD students and two chaperones received an all-expense-paid, four-day trip in Washington, D.C. The students participating were chosen from 46 schools representing 20 Arizona districts, covering eleven cities and four counties in Arizona. This amazing trip was made possible with support and collaboration from Governor Ducey, Mr. Bidwell, owner of the Arizona Cardinals, Dianne Smith, Executive Director of Greater Phoenix Management Council, and other generous donors.

During the four days in the nation's capital, our students and teachers had the opportunity to meet with elected officials and attend workshops to see first-hand how government works. The students visited Capitol Hill, Arlington National Cemetery, the National Museum of African American History and Culture, the Smithsonian, and more iconic American landmarks.

Thanks also to our students and their families, as well as staff members for their support to make this once-in-a-lifetime trip possible.
