- **Free WIFI from Cox Communications**

Cox Communications has an extensive network of wireless hotspots available at no charge. To log onto a Cox hotspot:

- Open your device and power on
- If not prompted with a WIFI selection, click on the time at the bottom right hand side of the screen
- Click below the WIFI symbol where it says “Not Connected”
- Find the Cable WIFI or Cox WiFi wireless network from the list of available networks and connect to it
- You will be taken to a screen in Chrome where you will need to accept the terms and conditions for services. You will be prompted to enter your name, and email address
- Check “I agree”
- You will not need to log in or register
- Note that this is NOT a secured network
