News from CTE (Career and Technical Education)

When teaching program area industry standards and in lab settings, TUHSD teachers and students in Culinary Arts, Medical Assisting Services, and Sports Medicine & Rehabilitation Services often use the much sought after Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) you have probably heard about in recent news. The Career and Technical Education Division of the Arizona Department of Education gave the official approval for local CTE programs to donate to the COVID-19 cause. The approval came via ADE/CTE because many of the industry related supplies that programs have on hand are paid for with state or federal grant funds.
