

West Point High School does its part to contribute during the COVID-19 crisis


West Point High School Engineering was able to 3-D print and donate items that support Personal Protective Equipment used by local healthcare workers. Once printed the 3-dimensional parts must be sealed in Ziplock bags for a minimum of 72 hours before then can be donated. The printed mask parts are worn on the forehead and ear guards are used to preserve the backs of healthcare workers' ears from the wear and tear that the mask straps cause. The filament used to print 3-D items can go bad if it's not utilized in a timely manner. It was purchased with Perkins Grant funds.




West Point High School teacher, Gabi Gabaldon, dons one of her personally designed masks (not intended for use in the healthcare field) with 3-D parts she printed
