Mitigation Strategies

Continue to Monitor and Follow CDC and MCDPH Guidelines:

CDC Operational Strategy for K-12 Schools through Phased Mitigation

- Consistent Implementation of 5 Layered Mitigation Strategies
- Each mitigation strategy provides some level of protection with layered strategies providing the greatest level.



Mitigation Strategies

LAYERS:

- 1. Use of masks
- 2. Physical distancing
- 3. Handwashing and respiratory etiquette
- 4. Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities
- 5. Monitoring of cases with contact tracing in combination with isolation/quarantine

TVHS Students and other
Pandemic Online Learners Move
to Traditional High School Online
Learning Starting Fall 2021

TVHS will run as an AOI in the Summer 2022

About 150 students district-wide express interest in remaining online for the Fall 2021.

Summer school courses will be offered according to the needs of the students and available TVHS courses.

TUHSD can offer remote instruction at traditional schools over the 180 day school calendar.

TVHS summer courses allow TUHSD to be competitive with other online summer programs.

Courses offered are the current course list for the TUHSD district in core areas. The elective offerings are the approved courses for TVHS for the coming school year.

TVHS will run as an AOI in the Summer 2022

The same instructional calendar will be followed by virtual learners and in-person learners.

Attendance will be recorded daily for virtual students each period.

Teachers will provide daily virtual instruction and support during the assigned period and time. Asynchronous and Synchronous instruction will be utilized.
